Policy 2

Standards Review

High standards serve as the foundation for credibility and effectiveness in the assessment and accreditation of educational programs. In order to be a member of CCEI, an accrediting agency must maintain and implement accreditation standards consistent with the CCEI International Framework for Chiropractic Education and Accreditation.

CCEI undertakes a periodic process of review to ensure that the CCEI International Framework for Chiropractic Education and Accreditation is clear, current and appropriately applicable to the roles of chiropractic education accrediting bodies worldwide, and to ensure proper rigor and effective performance in accreditation. This thorough process of review occurs at regular intervals. CCEI will also undertake housekeeping edits of these same documents on an incidental basis according to identified and substantiated needs. In all cases, authority and responsibility for approval of any such revisions will rest with the CCEI Board.

In conducting the regular periodic review process, CCEI will ensure that cognizant and properly interested parties are informed regarding the current the CCEI International Framework for Chiropractic Education and Accreditation and are invited to submit observations and recommendations in due time for consideration by CCEI.

To ensure that the accreditation standards of all CCEI member agencies remain consistent with the CCEI International Framework for Chiropractic Education and Accreditation, CCEI will review those standards on an ongoing basis.
